

Rules and Guidelines

Teams should be ready 10 minutes prior.

Teams should have same color jersey, number on front jersey

All must be in appropriate grade/age level

Players must play on only ONE team/grade level

Jewelry, watches, earrings removed

No one allowed on courts during someone else's game.

Boys 3-5th grade, girls, 28.5 ballsize

Boys 7th grade and up, 29.5 ballsize (wyoming exception)

Each team provides scorer's table personnel

1 timeout per team (1st half), 2 timeouts (2nd half), and 1 timeout for overtime. No carry.

Four (4) 10 minute quarters running time

Clock stops last 2 minutes of 4th 1/4 unless 10 point lead

Overtime, 1 minute stopped time (2nd sudden death)

All players 2-4th grade, may shoot FT from 12'

No full court press for 2-4th grades.

Warm-up, and half-time, 3 minutes

Free throws

Foul on 2-point FG (1 for 2 points)

Foul on 3-point FG (1 for 3 points)

Foul on made basket (1 for 1 point 'and-1)

1/1 on 5th foul each quarter (1 for 2 points)

*during the last 2 minutes of the game/4th quarter and OT, traditional free throws will issued for 2 shots, 3 shots, and double bonus
